To Whom It May Concern:

We are writing from the Foxborough Public Schools about two unique employment opportunities for new graduates. As a result of Department of Public Health grant funding we are presently able to add two School Clinician positions to our districtwide mental health team for the remainder of the school year. These individuals will support social, emotional, and behavioral needs with direct student services, parent consultation, staff collaboration, and collateral contacts. These individuals will work closely with, and receive support from, the districtwide mental health teams and varied community supports.

The Foxborough Public Schools is an ideal spot for new graduates to begin their career while gaining experience within a comprehensive school mental health program. We provide our students with social emotional screeners 3 times per year, Tier 1 SEL instruction in grades K-8, individual and group therapeutic support, along with other individualized support for students as needed. The mental health professionals filling these roles will have access to clinical supervision from a Licensed Mental Health Counselor and be able to complete the 450 on-site hours needed to gain an initial School Adjustment/Social Worker license from the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education in Massachusetts.

Canidates identifying as BIPOC and/or with competencies in multiple languages are strongly encouraged to apply for this position supporting Foxborough's diverse community.

Please forward this information to any past or present students in your program who will hold a Masters degree by January 2024 and may be interested in working as K-12 School Clinician.
